About the Cinema

The State Cinema was opened in 1913 and, apart from a short period, has operated as a theatre and cinema, since that time.

The Cinema is nestled in the heart of the cosmopolitan North Hobart restaurant strip and is a wonderful blend of the original art deco styling with a modern café bar and facilities.

Our facilities include a fully licensed café bar, where you can enjoy great coffee, Tasmanian wines and premium beers, and delicious snacks all sourced from local makers. The café can handle up to 66 people seated or over 200 in a cocktail party format. It is ideal for an opening night or just a pleasant coffee before or after the cinema.

If you would like to make a group booking to a regular scheduled session, the details on the following pages will give you a guide as to costs and requirements. Please have a look through this information and email us if you need any more details.

A minimum of 24 hours notice is required for group bookings. Session times are available each Tuesday morning for the film week commencing Thursday. Group Bookings do not include private use of a cinema, members of the public can purchase tickets to the session also.

Group Bookings

Group admission to a scheduled, public session

Group Bookings are for the bulk purchase of discount tickets to a specific scheduled public session. Group Bookings must be confirmed and tickets purchased, in a single transaction, no less than 24 hours prior to the screening which you are attending. Tickets apply only to the session stated, and cannot be transferred, refunded or exchanged for cash. You will be sharing the auditorium with members of the public.

Booking Ahead

Groups of 30 and over persons may be able to book up to 14 days ahead to a future session.

You can select a current film and nominate a date – check our film guide for screening dates <http://www.statecinema.com.au/filmguide/> - and an approximate time bracket from the following

Commencing between:

- 11am – 12pm, 1.30pm – 2.30pm, 4.00pm – 4.30pm **Monday to Friday**
- 6.00 – 7.00pm, 8.30 – 9.00pm **Monday, Wednesday, Thursday**
- 8.00pm – 9.00pm **Sunday**

Times are approximate, and may actually vary within 15 minutes of these guidelines

If the booking is confirmed, the exact session time will be notified on the Tuesday prior to the screening, at which time tickets can be collected.

The booked session will be open to the public, and a minimum commitment to buy 30 tickets must be made to confirm the booking.

Cancellations to booked ahead group bookings will incur a fee.

Bar and Café Service

The State Cinema has a café bar onsite, from which hot and cold drinks, confectionary, cakes, snacks and light meals can be purchased. All drinks and confectionary may be consumed within the auditoriums also.

The Cinema holds a liquor license allowing the sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises. Supply of alcohol to any individual will be at the sole discretion of the staff of the State Cinema and will comply with the laws of Tasmania.

Any beverages, non-alcoholic or alcoholic, to be consumed on the premises will be sold and served by cinema staff only. There is no BYO of any drinks.

Exclusive use of foyer space is not available.

Miscellaneous

You may use the State Cinema name and logo for the purpose of advertising your event, however, you must ensure that you do not make any undertakings that you are unlikely to be able to deliver or which may adversely impact the reputation of the State Cinema.

You will agree to indemnify the State Cinema, and its staff, against any action caused through your negligence or that of your staff, contractors or agents.

You will be liable to compensate the State Cinema, where any incorrect advertisement or omission of fact causes undue duress to our staff or the reputation of the cinema.
